2017 SPRING ENROLLMENT SNAPSHOT FOR ILLINOIS PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES

Summary: This report is includes an analysis of spring enrollment over the past

three academic years for the Illinois public universities. It focuses on full-time-equivalent (FTE) enrollment at the undergraduate and graduate levels, as well as FTE undergraduate and graduate enrollment

combined.

Total FTE enrollment at Illinois public universities is down in spring 2017, but the decline is largely being driven by the decline in total undergraduate enrollment. Total graduate enrollment has remained relatively flat over the past three academic years and actually increased slightly in spring of 2016. Also, there was a large amount of variation in enrollment change between the public universities.

SPRING ENROLLMENT SNAPSHOT FOR ILLINOIS PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES

This following report provides a 2017 spring enrollment snapshot for Illinois public universities and includes information covering the last three academic years.

As shown in *Table 1*, in 2016-17 total full-time equivalent (FTE) enrollment is down by -2.8 percent (-4,451 FTE) from 2015-16, but the decline is largely being driven by the -3.5 percent (-4,204 FTE) decline in undergraduate enrollment. Total graduate enrollment has remained relatively flat over the past three academic years.

Undergraduate Enrollment (based on FTE)

As shown in *Table 2*, overall undergraduate enrollment at Illinois public universities was fairly stable in moving from the spring of 2014-15 to the spring of 2015-16 (-839 FTE or -0.7 percent); however, it declined by -3.5 percent (-4,204 FTE) from spring of 2015-16 to spring of 2016-17. There was quite a bit of variation in spring enrollment in 2016-17 between the public universities: undergraduate enrollment growth was limited to the schools within the University of Illinois system, and Governors State University experienced roughly flat undergraduate enrollment. Chicago State University (-34.7 percent) and Eastern Illinois University (-18.9 percent) experienced the largest enrollment declines in spring of 2016-17, after experiencing the largest declines in the previous spring of 2015-16.

Graduate Enrollment (based on FTE)

After a modest increase in total graduate enrollment from 2014-15 to 2015-16 (+701 FTE or 1.8 percent), graduate enrollment was relatively flat in comparing spring of 2015-16 to spring of 2016-17 (-247 FTE or -0.6 percent). After experiencing a modest loss of graduate students in 2015-16, graduate enrollment at Southern Illinois University Carbondale increased by 20.0 percent (+437 FTE) in 2016-17. The University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign experienced a 4.1 percent increase in graduate enrollment (+533 FTE) from 2015-16 to 2016-17. When comparing spring enrollment in AY 2016-17 to AY 2015-16, all of the other public universities either experienced flat enrollment (such as Northeastern Illinois University, Western Illinois University, and Southern Illinois University Edwardsville) or notable declines (University of Illinois at Springfield, Governors State University, Northern Illinois University, Chicago State University, and Illinois State University).
